
New Freshman Applications, Acceptances and Enrollment Fall 2015 - Fall 2021




Transfer Applications, Acceptances and Enrollment Fall 2015 - Fall 2021




New Freshman Completed Applications and Enrollment by Gender Fall 2015 - Fall 2021

Notes:

- 1. Freshmen who enter the University in the fall or preceding summer term are counted as "new freshmen." Similarly, transfer students entering in the fall or preceding summer term are counted as "transfer students" for the fall semester.
- 2. "Transfer students" refers to the entering summer/fall group of transfer students. For example, in Fall 2021 the 364 entering transfer students comprised 2.4% of the 15,191 ernolled undergraduates. However, for Fall 2021 the total number of enrolled undergraduates who had transferred into the University consisted of (a) new transfers who entered in Fall 2021 and (b) students who transferred into the University in previous academic years. Generally, the total enrollment of students who had entered as transfer students is approximately 10-15% of the undergraduate student body.




Enrollment by Gender Fall 2015 - Fall 2021



^{*} In 2010, in order to fulfill new federal government reporting requirements on race and ethnicity, students were given the opportunity to select multiple race categories. In addition, Pacific Islander was designated as its own category (separate from Asian). The students were asked two questions. The first question asked the student "Are you Hispanic/Latino?" The second question allowed students to select among five race categories, with multiple responses allowed.


In this table, students are counted in only one race/ethnic group category. If the student indicated "yes" to the first question, the student was categorized as Hispanic (only) regardless of any race code(s) they may have selected. If the student marked more than one race (and "no" to Hispanic/Latino in the first question), he/she was reported in the category of Multiracial.









Students From Texas by County Fall 2021





Headcount Enrollment Percentage by Unit Fall 2015 - Fall 2021














Average Compensation of Full-Time Instructional Faculty on Academic Year Contracts 2014-15 through 2020-21





Tuition, Room and Board Charges 2015-16 through 2021-22










