# **Enrollment by Program and Major, Spring 2017**

This report presents a summary of Spring 2017 enrollment by students' programs and major fields of study. The report is separated into four sections: breakdown of dual programs, primary programs, secondary programs, and all majors. Programs and majors are sorted by the academic unit. In all reports, the class is based on the student's classification within his or her primary program.

The first section shows the number of students who are working toward completion of two degree programs concurrently. These programs can be within the graduate school or across different levels of the institution (seminary/graduate, law/graduate, etc.).

The final section, Enrollment by All Majors, includes a student's first and second major in their primary program as well as a first and second major in their secondary program. Therefore, this section represents a duplicated headcount.
