<sup>\*</sup>Full-Time Equivalent (FTE): The full-time equivalent of Baylor's part-time enrollment is estimated by totaling the number of hours of all part-time students and dividing by the number of hours needed to be a full-time student at that level and term (12 hours for undergraduate semester students; 9 hours for seminary semester students, graduate semester and trimester (online) students; 6 hours for online MBA and graduate quarter (online) students; and 10 hours for law students). The results are then added to the full-time enrollment headcounts to obtain an FTE for all students enrolled.
