Notes:

1. Freshmen who enter the University in the fall or preceding summer term are counted as "new freshmen." Similarly, transfer students entering in the fall or preceding summer term are counted as "transfer students" for the fall semester.
2. "Transfer students" refers to the entering summer/fall group of transfer students. For example, in Fall 2021 the 364 entering transfer students comprised $2.4 \%$ of the 15,191 ernolled undergraduates. However, for Fall 2021 the total number of enrolled undergraduates who had transferred into the University consisted of (a) new transfers who entered in Fall 2021 and (b) students who transferred into the University in previous academic years. Generally, the total enrollment of students who had entered as transfer students is approximately $10-15 \%$ of the undergraduate student body.
